Warbirds Over Mundijong - Another Great Success

Once again Warbirds Over Mundijong 2011 proved to be WA's premier warbird event. Celebrating its 12th year at KAMS, nearly 40 pilots with 59 aircraft enjoyed a marvellous day where warbirds from every theatre of war were presented. Some of the models were scratch built beauties, others ARF's or kit built but this is the whole point of our day. Warbirds Over Mundijong is a warbird scale rally when you can enjoy many varied aircraft both on the ground and in the air. Spitfires, Mustangs & Corsairs represented some of the WWII models. A superb Pilatus Porter from the Vietnam War. An F-16 of Thunderbirds fame and a stunning F-22 Raptor (both models turbine powered) from recent conflicts are only a small representation of what the 150 odd spectators saw on the day.

The crowd was also entertained at lunchtime with a tribute flight of models from the "Those Magnificent Men in their Flying Machines" movie for our friend and co-founder of the event Vic Longbon who passed away in 2006.

Although not a competition, we do present some awards on the day. The best take-off of the day went to Richard Bloor for his fabulous 'Aviatik'. The best landing of the day went to Rick Brayford from Wanneroo with his 'FW 190'. The annual Vic Longbon Memorial Award awarded to the pilot who best presents and flies his model on the day, went to Keith Willans for his superb Pilatus Porter. Electric powered and complete with a built in sound system for absolute realism in flight. Well done Keith.

The day couldn't be the success it is without our sponsors. Dean Allison from Discount Hobby Supplies in Willetton donated an OS 95AX motor which was our raffle prize and Scott Kerison from Ace Models in Midland donated \$180 in gift vouchers for the 3 pilot awards.
