General Business:

- Geoff Doughty suggested all FPV operators at the field comply with CASA MOP as outlined in the slipstream.
- Geoff Doughty reminded everyone not to leave Lipo Batteries at the field.
- Geoff Doughty outlined the current budget situation and asked members to consider carefully the pace at which we may be able to proceed with the upgrade to the central pits Area.
- Quad Bike theft. The insurance company has agreed to completely replace the bike. Discussion was held regarding the type of shed lock and committee is looking into this. Eric Gooch has agreed to proceed with repair of the fence this weekend. Immobilizers will be fitted to the new bike.
- Security situation at the field was discussed. Ideas involved installation of security bollards within the shed or outside. It was decided that the new bike should not be returned to the field until the security situation is resolved.
- Keith Wilans presented an alternative quote for the same type of security system but with 3 large halogen lights for \$2700.00.
- Motion was put to immediately install camera security system as discussed at \$2700.00


NEW LOCATION FOR K.A.M.S CLUB MEETING NOW AT ROYAL AERO CLUB – JANDAKOT AIRPORT
