**Committee Business:**

### **BY-LAW OF THE MONTH**

#### **4.4 SWITCHING RADIO ON**

The transmitter should be switched on before the receiver, and the receiver switched off before the transmitter.

The throttle trim should be set so that the engine will stop when the trim is moved to the low position.

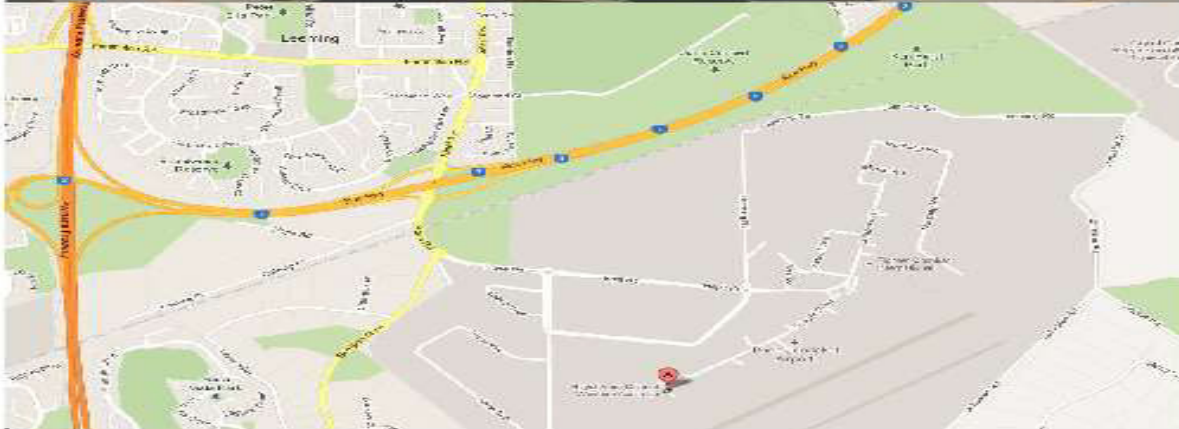
#### **4.5 CHECK CONTROLS**

Always carry out a pre-flight radio check to make sure the control surfaces are operating and that their movement directions are coinciding with the transmitter commands.

**Ensure aerial is extended prior to attempting to fly.**
