Motor Balancing anyone?

Well, I know you all balance your props - don't you??

I've always carefully balanced my props using a magnetic balancer and when done went off convinced that all was well. Recently, while lurking around in a quad copter site, I saw some discussion regarding electric motors and how they can be out of balance. Until now I thought a motor would run true given the modern manufacturing methods employed today. In fact, for general use with a balanced prop it would be unlikely that the normally accepted tolerances would be a problem. However, it seems that motor imbalance does become an issue when an aircraft is used as a video platform.
